Legislative Update

We have two important bills that we are working on and would like to encourage you to contact your Senator and ask them for a “yes” vote.

SB 50

SB 50 would eliminate pretextual traffic stops that are unnecessary to protect public safety, but, tragically, too often lead to violent encounters between law enforcement and motorists, especially persons of color. In recent years, there have been hundreds of deaths arising from such traffic stops. SB 50 would further the just, equitable, and fair enforcement of the law for all people, to provide for the fair and transparent administration of the Motor Vehicle Code with respect to all and improve law enforcements standing in the community.

SB 309

SB 309 will align state law with the heightened protections to religious exercise pertaining to clothing, headwear and grooming, for individuals incarcerated and imprisoned, as already required under RLIUPA and in the spirit of the Constitution.

This bill also alleviates costs incurred across state departments and agencies to conduct case-by-case analysis, address complaints, amend local policies to permit religious expression, and represent itself in numerous lawsuits initiated by or on behalf of inmates denied religious accommodation.
